BACK AGAIN THIS YEAR!

Online Registration **starts January 1, 2019!** We as a league are working with the Olmsted Community Center to help inform our community and others moving into our community of the possibilities of playing baseball or slow-pitch softball in our area. Beginning January 1, you will be able to log onto the Community Center website (<http://olmstedcc.com>) and register your son or daughter to play ball! **Register on or before January 31st to earn a \$5 discount per player.**

Due to the new Lindsay's Law that went into effect in 2017 per Senate Bill 252, OCSL will have **online registration only**. This will allow you to sign off on Lindsay's Law and watch the necessary video to inform you and the participant you are registering about Sudden Cardiac Arrest in youth athletes.

REGISTRATION 2019

Registration is NOW OPEN. Visit the Olmsted Community Center website at <http://olmstedcc.com> to register. You may contact the Olmsted Community Center with any questions at (440) 427-1599.

Register on or before January 31, 2019, to earn a \$5 discount per player. The last day to register without a late fee is March 15, 2019. **Late fee registrations will only be accepted until April 15, 2019, if there is available space in the desired league(s).** Payment for registrations not accepted after the April 15th deadline will be refunded.

THE FAMILY MAXIMUM THROUGH MARCH 15, 2019, is \$235.00. Late fees are **not** included in the family maximum. Proof of age may be required at a later date for all leagues. Registrations may be limited due to field availability.

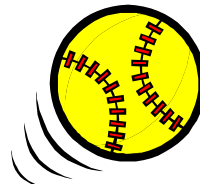
